Introduction

We take data protection incredibly seriously, we are GDPR registered, hold data and emails only on encrypted servers and have introduced other measures to keep your data safe.

This privacy policy notice is served by the **PACT Dogs Ltd**. The purpose of this policy is to explain to you how we control, process, handle and protect your personal information through the business and while you browse or use this website. Where our purpose for processing is as follows:

Courses

- To be able to contact your next of kin if an emergency were to arise at any point during the course.

- Pass on your professional contact information to the ABTC (Animal Behaviour and Training Council) to be displayed in their online register.

Data security and protection:

We ensure the security of any personal information we hold by using secure data storage technologies and precise procedures in how we store, access and manage that information. Our methods meet the GDPR compliance requirement.

Our data is stored on secure Google Drive encrypted servers which comply with EU GDPR, data and Email are HTTPS encrypted, they are also ISO 27001 certified and audited regularly to ensure compliance with regulation.

We have also moved to 2-step verification for logging into our systems to dramatically reduce the potential for a successful data hack.

Data retention period:

From time to time we are audited, for these reasons we may need to hold onto data for up to 7 years beyond the delivery of a course or expiration of membership. Please contact us via office@pact-dogs.com if you wish to request your data to be removed earlier than this date and we will endeavour to fulfil your request.

Courses

Your data is stored for up to seven years beyond the completion of a course, or follow on membership, whichever is the later date.

Membership

Your data is stored from your membership application, and 7 year after notification of non-renewal, this will be for the sole purpose of assisting in an external audit.

Events

We will continue to process your information under this basis until you withdraw consent, or it is determined your consent no longer exists.

Mailing Lists

We will continue to process your information under this basis until you withdraw consent, or it is determined your consent no longer exists.

Sharing your information: We do not and will not share your information with third parties.

Internet cookies

Our website site uses cookies – small text files that are placed on your machine to help the site provide a better user experience.
