COURSE SYLLABUS

This course is Level 4. Content is released online on a weekly basis. Each week you will receive a lecture and a practical tutorial. Over the course of the 23 weeks, you will be set 4 written assignments and will work on a practical homework project involving training your own dog. These will be submitted to the team for marking to ensure that you are making appropriate progress and to receive feedback about what you are doing well and aspects that you could develop. There are 3 online Q&A sessions and also 4 inperson teaching days so that you can receive some face to face coaching and training to prepare for your theory and practical assessments. The course and assessments have been designed to be completed within 12 months, and we hope that all students will be ABTC ATI accredited within 18 months of their enrolment. Student membership can be renewed for a further 12 months if required for a small fee.



ASSESSMENT & ACCREDITATION

Once all the course content, your theory exam (50 multiple choice questions) and your log sheet (75 hours a mix of coaching, shadowing and training hours) have been completed you will submit 2 videos of you teaching. 1 x 1:1 session up to 20 minutes and a group session with a minimum of 3 dogs and handlers up to 30 minutes. You will receive feedback and following successful completion you will become a full member of PACT and able to register with the ABTC as an ATI (80% plus criteria demonstrated).


KEY DATES 2024

As part of your course, you are given the opportunity to attend 2 in-person fieldwork sessions. These take place over 2 days and are usually held at our outdoor venue in Southampton. There is some flexibility with this and remote support can be provided if travel is difficult or the cost is prohibitive. These sessions aim to prepare you for your theory and practical assessments by practicing teaching techniques, workshops and discussions.









BOOKING & PAYMENT

Exams, assignments & assessments included in course (1st attempts). All students are required to pay a £175 deposit to reserve their space before payment in full or instalments is then arranged.

PAYMENT PLANS: HOW DO THEY WORK?

We're keen that our courses are accessible to as many people as possible and that we don't create any unnecessary financial barriers to our students. We therefore offer a flexible payment plan which looks like this:

STEP 1: Pay £175 deposit to reserve your space

STEP 2: Receive an invoice for the remaining balance of £2625

STEP 3: Send payments via bank transfer as often as you can

STEP 4: Pay the balance within 6 months of your deposit payment
